

**Description:** The healthcare professionals in Pakistan need to be educated in Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion (DEI) in view of the diverse and multi-ethnic cultural and religious beliefs. This can assure safe and quality care provision, especially in the vulnerable pediatric population. The study employs the use of a Critical Incident Framework to identify culture shock that can be used to teach multi-disciplinary healthcare providers to deal efficiently with cultural shock situations. The development of curricula in consensus with Anthropologists can result in increased awareness about cultural sensitivity.
